



## Articulation Agreement



This articulation agreement is entered into by and between the Texas Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) and Northwestern State University of Louisiana for the following effort:

- I. **STATEMENT OF WORK:** Both parties agree to work cooperatively for the acceptance of TEEX Emergency Medical Technician (EMT-Paramedic) courses for college credit within the Bachelor of Science in Unified Public Safety Administration with a Concentration in Fire and Emergency Medical Services Administration.
  
- II. **RESPONSIBILITIES:**
  - A. TEXAS ENGINEERING EXTENSION SERVICE will:
    1. Maintain, deliver and administer the Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic (1,033 Hrs) certificate program. Make the EMT-Paramedic curriculum available to Northwestern State for review and evaluation
  
    2. Verify completion of TEEX certificates with students and Northwestern State University of Louisiana to assist students complete Northwestern State University of Louisiana admission requirements.
  
  - B. Northwestern State University of Louisiana will:
    1. In alignment with Exhibit A, accept TEEX EMT-Paramedic for credit within the Northwestern State University of Louisiana Bachelor of Science in Unified Public Safety Administration with a Concentration in Fire and Emergency Medical Services Administration for a maximum of 25 credits.
      - a. CJ 4475- Homeland Security (3 hrs)
      - b. UPSA 2000- Personnel Management Issues (3 hrs)
      - c. USPA 2100- Homeland Security and Emergency Management (3 hrs)
      - d. USPA 2250- Concepts of Emergency Medical Service (3 hrs)
      - e. USPA 2400- Introduction to Corporate & Municipal Emergency (3 hrs)

- f. USPA 2500- Social Dimensions of Disaster (3 hrs)
- g. USPA 2700- Planning and Decision-Making in Public Organizations (3 hrs)
- h. USPA 2900- Managerial Issues in Hazardous Materials (3 hrs)
- i. 1 hour elective

2. Update TEEEX with any changes in the degree plan the impacts TEEEX course transfer eligibility.


III. TERMS OF AGREEMENT: This Agreement shall begin as of the date of the last signature, and terminate August 31, 2015, unless terminated by either party. Both parties reserve the right to terminate this Agreement for reasonable cause of if it is determined the objective of the project cannot be accomplished. A party in writing thirty (30) days in advance.

If this Agreement is not executed by all parties within 60 days of date of the first signature below, then this Agreement will be null and void end of no further effect.
